She motivated students to develop confidence, leadership skills, and career awareness for their future.

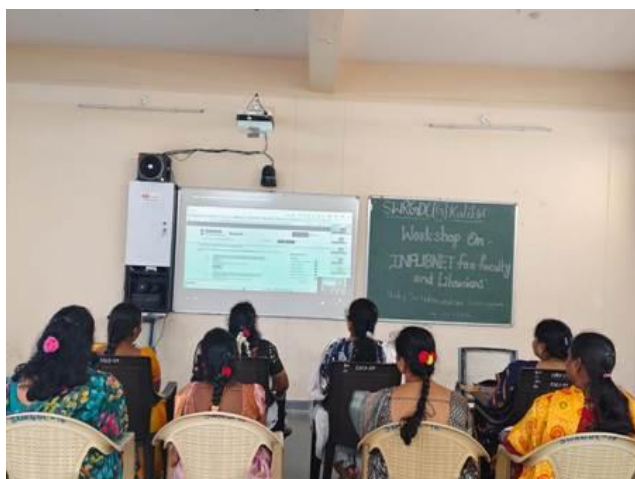
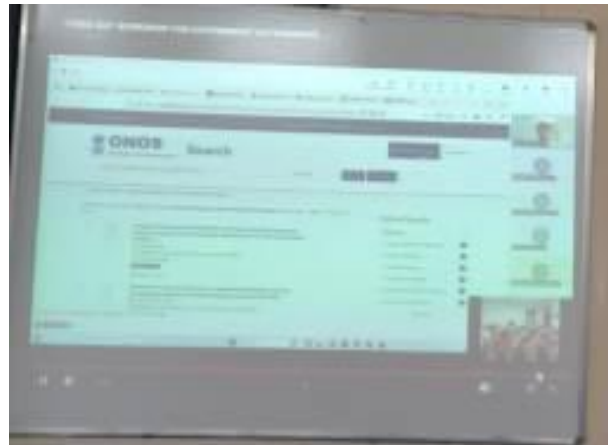
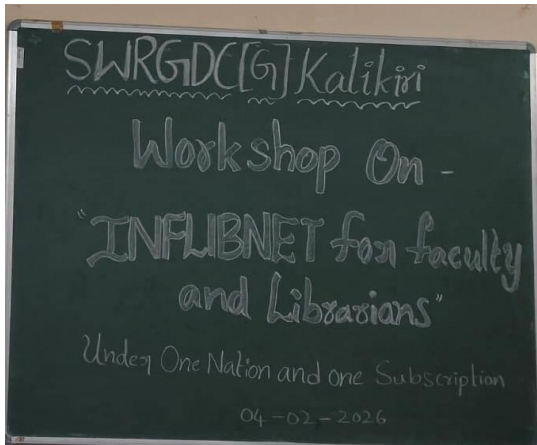

SAROJINI NAIDU JAYANTHI

Women Empowerment Cell and N.S.S. Department has observed the 147th birth anniversary of Sarojini Naidu on 13th February 2026.

N.S.S. Co-ordinators and the HOD of Telugu Department Dr. S. Gulab Jan, Dr. L. Anjali Devi, Principal, and other staff and students participated in it. On this occasion, Principal Dr. L. Anjali Devi and N.S.S. Co-ordinators addressed the staff and students and said that Sarojini Naidu was born on 13th February 1879 in Hyderabad (Present Telangana state) during the British rule. She was an Indian political activist and poet who served as the first Governor of the United Provinces after India's independence. She was the first Indian woman to be the President of the Indian National Congress and was appointed as the Governor of a state. She was known as the "Nightingale of India" (Bharat Kokila). Due to her contributions to women's empowerment, February 13 is recognized as National Women's Day in India.

She was a renowned poet, with works like "The Golden Threshold", "The Broken Wing", and "The Bird of Time." She passed away on March 2, 1949.

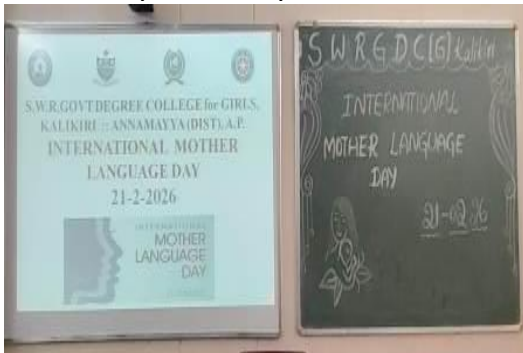
INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY

DEATH ANNIVERSARY OF UYYALAVADA NARASIMHA REDDY

The death anniversary of Uyyalavada Narasimha Reddy been observed by the Telugu Department Head, DR.S.Gulab Jan, on 22-2-2026.

Dr.s.Gulabjan Jan addressed the staff and students that Uyyalavada Nareasima Reddy was on Indian freedom fighter leader. Son of a farmer Telugu palegaaru mallareddy and seethamma. He was born in Rupanagudi Village on 24 November 1806.He belonged to the motati clan of Reddys. He and his commander in chief vadde obanna were at the heart of freedom movement against company rule in India in 1847, were 5000 Indian peasants rose up in revolt against the British East India company in Nandyala district.

On 22nd February 1847, he was executed in koilakuntla in front of a crowd of over 2000 people and his head was hung on the fort wall for 30 years to not to revolt against Britishers.

The Department of Sciences of our college observed 'National Science Day' on 28 February 2026.

The HOD of Sciences Smt.K.Madhavi said that 'National Science Day' is celebrated in India on February 28 each Year to mark the discovery of the Raman Effect by Indian Physicist Sir. C.V Raman on 28 February 1928. This discovery earned him the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930, making him the first Indian to win a Nobel in the Sciences.

The theme for National Science Day, 2026 is "Empowering Indian Youth for Global Leadership in Science & Innovation for VIKSIT Bharat". The theme will focus on encouraging young minds, recognizing ground breaking contributions and celebrating India's scientific achievements.
