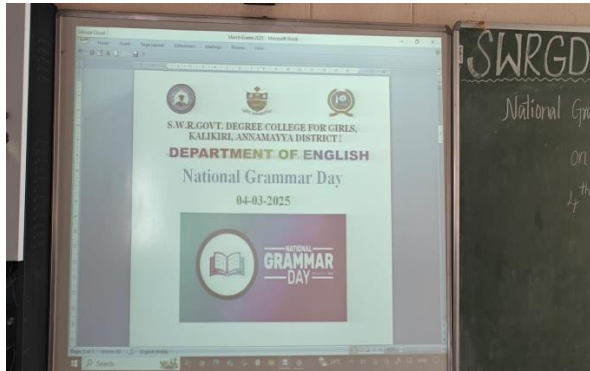

The theme for Pi Day 2025 is, Mathematics Art and Creativity.





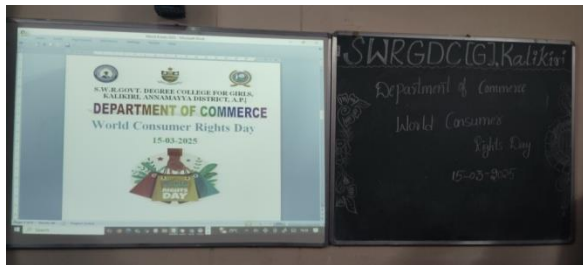

The Department of Telugu observed the anniversary of Rayprolu Subba rao on 17th March, 2025. DR.S.Gulab Jan, Head of Telugu Department saide that Ray Prolu Subba Rao in also known as Abhinava Nannaya of Telugu literature. He was born in Guntur district on 17th March 1892 and breathed his last on 30 June 1984.

He was a recipient of Sahitya academi Award to Telugu writers of his poetic work Misna Manjari in 1965. He was inspired by the Western literary movement and brought romanticism into Telugu literature by breaking away from the traditional translations of Sanscrit literature. He introduced the concept of 'Amalina Shringara Tathvamu' into Telugu literature.

Subbarao's literature was a mixture of Telugu Indian culture and Western ideas. He followed classical Sanskrit and Telugu meter in his writings and he didn't abandont Sanskrit Telugu from Common language .His literature theme include sensual meterial, love of nature, Patriotism, sprituality, humanitarianism and social reforms.





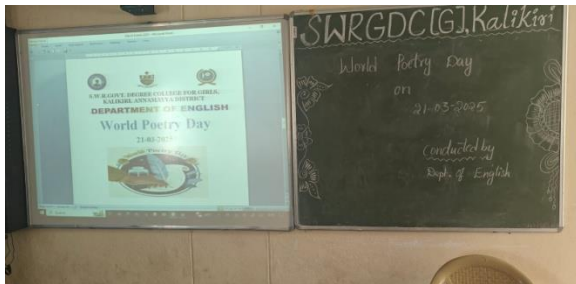

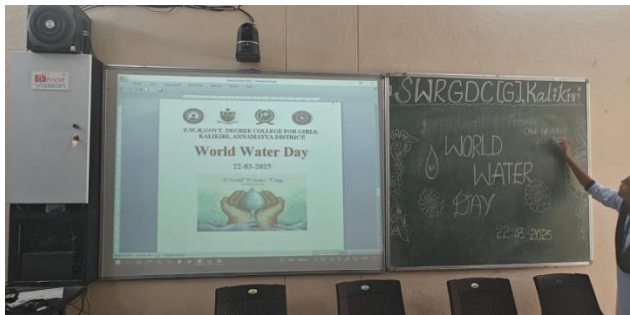
