Andhra state was the first state to be formed on a linguistic basis in India on 1st October 1953 on 1st November 1956, A.P. state was merged with Telugu speaking areas of the Hyderabad state to form Andhra Pradesh. Through the states reorganization Act of 1956, the state of Hyderabad was split up and its Telugu speaking districts (Constituting Telangana) joined with the Andhra State.

In 1953, Tanguturi Prakasam from the INC became the first CM of Andhra state in 1956. Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy from the INC became the first CM of Andhra Pradesh post the reorganisation of Indian states.

NATIONAL CANCER DAY

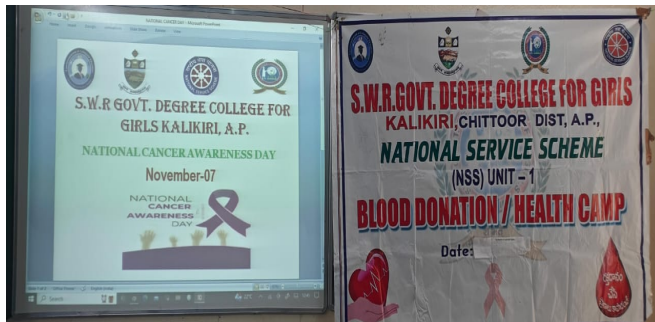
National cancer awareness Day is observed on the 7th of November in India every year since 2014 to create public awareness about early detection, prevention and treatment of cancer.

SIR.C.V.RAMAN ANNIVERSARY

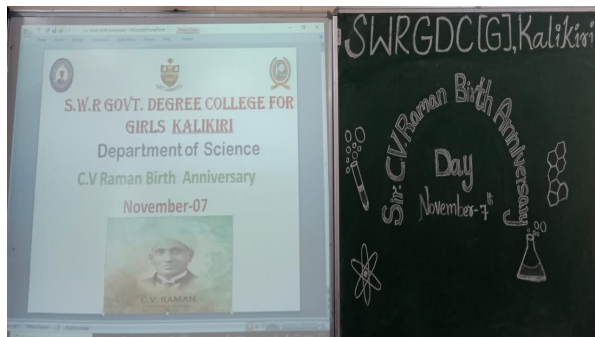
The Head of the department of mathematics, smt. K. Madhavi, conducted a programme on C.V.Raman's Anniversary in the college on 7th November 2024.

The students and the staff attended the programme, smt.K.Madhavi remarked that Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Ramana FRS, known as C.V.Raman, was an Indian physicist known for his work in the field of light scattering using a spectrograph that he developed, he and his student K.S.Krishnan discovered that when light traverses a transparent material, the light deflected light changes its wavelength.

Chandrasekhara Venkata Ramana was born at Tirucharapalli in southern India on November 7th, 1888. He studied at presidency college, Madras in 1902 and in 1904 passed BA examination, won the gold medal in physics in 1907 he gained his MA degree obtaining the highest distinctions.

Sir C.V. Raman was the first Indian to receive the Nobel prize in physics in 1930. He was awarded for his discovering of new radiation effect on February 28, 1928.

One prominent figure often referred to as the Father of physics in India is Sir C.V. Raman. The British Govt. knighted 'sir' in 1929. He became the first Indian director of the Indian Institute of Science [IISc] Bangalore in 1933.

NATIONAL LEGAL SERVICES DAY

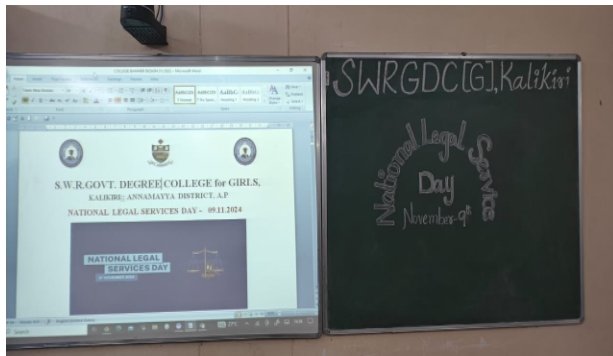
National Legal Service Day was observed in the college on 9th November 2024.

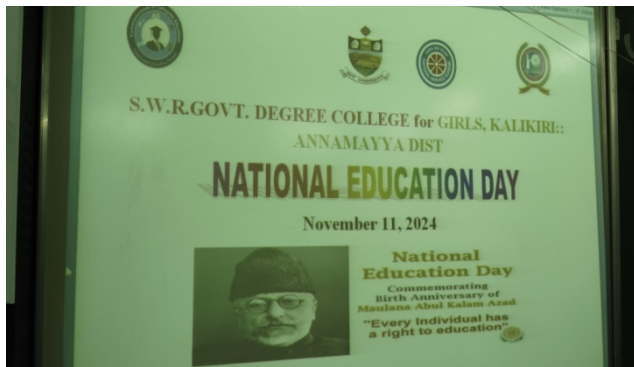
NATIONAL EDUCATIONAL DAY

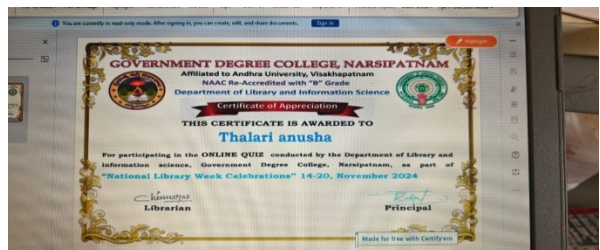
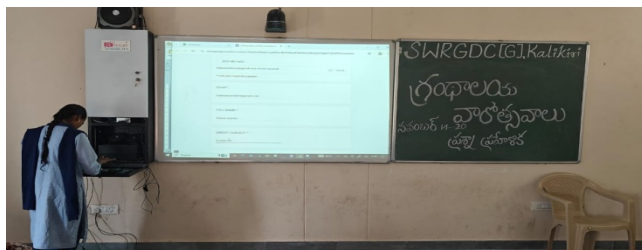

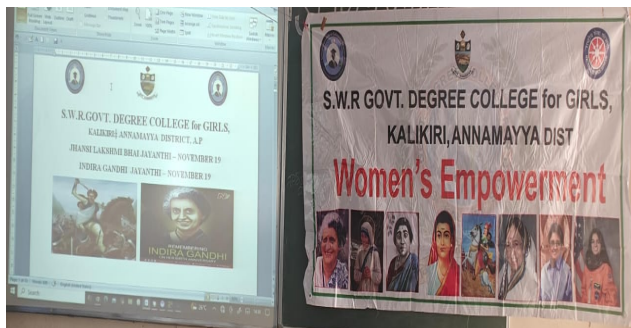
JHANSI LAKSHMI BAI JAYANTHI AND INDIRA GANDHI JAYANTHI

Indira Priyadarshini Gandhi was an Indian Politician and states woman who served as the Prime Minister of India from 1966 to 1977 and again from 1980 until her association in 1984. She was the daughter of Jawahar lal Nehru, The first Prime Minister of India and the mother of Rajiv Gandhi.

The prohibition of child marriage Act 2006 replaced the child marriage Restraint Act 1929. According to the 2006 Act, child marriage refers to a marriage where the age of the groom (male) is less than 21yrs or the age of the bride (girl) is less than 18yrs.
