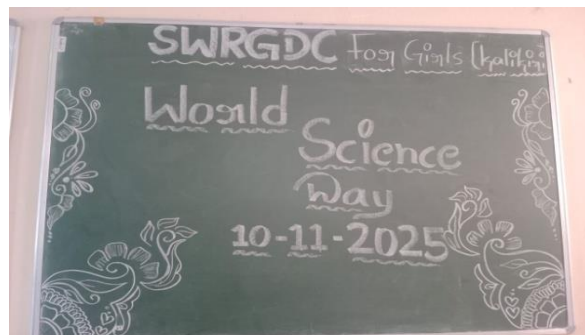
### WORLD SCIENCE DAY

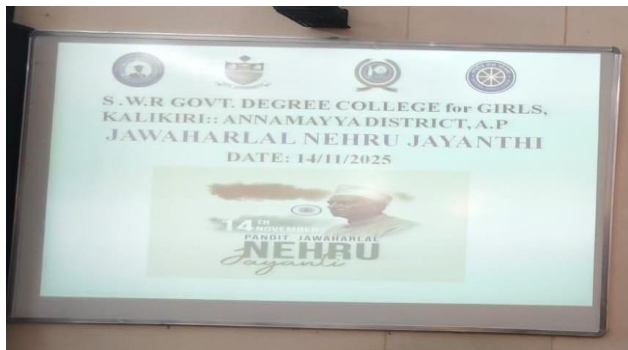
### JAWAHARLAL NEHRU JAYANTHI

Students were guided about courses offered by HIMS, admission procedures, eligibility criteria, and future scope.

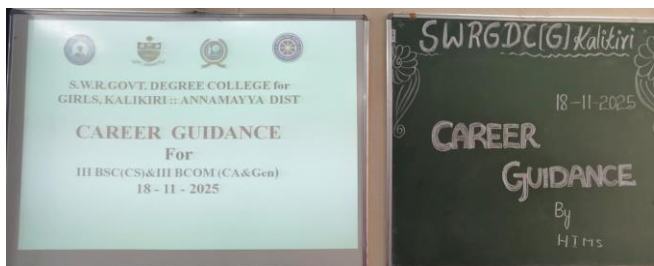
Experts explained the importance of communication skills, personality development, and soft skills in modern careers.

Indira Priyadarshini Gandhi was an Indian Politician and states woman who served as the Prime Minister of India from 1966 to 1977 and again from 1980 until her assosination in 1984. She was the daughter of Jawagar lal Nehru, The first Prime Minister of India and the mother of Rajiv Gandhi.

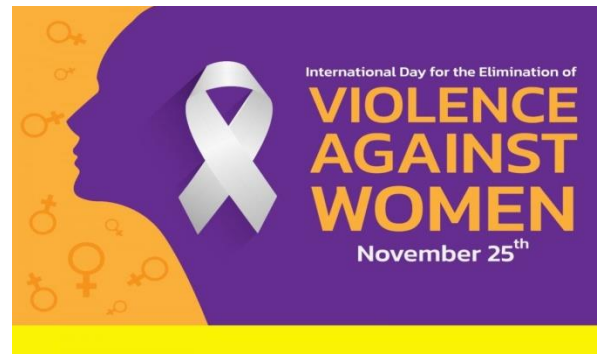
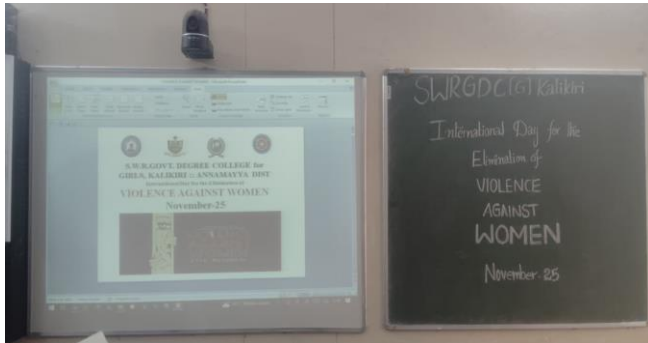
The event began with an introduction on the significance of this international day.

Parliament has enacted the prohibition of child marriage Act 2006 to prohibit child marriage, protect and provide relief to victims and enhance punishment for those who abet, promote or solemnize such marriage.

The prohibition of child marriage Act 2006 replaced the child marriage Restraint Act 1929. According to the 2006 Act, child marriage refers to a marriage where the age of the groom (male) is less than 21yrs or the age of the bride (girl) is less than 18yrs.
